VENTURA COUNTY SECURITY ASSOCIATION FORMS

Moorpark, California, April, 12, 2007 – The Ventura County Security Association (VCSA) held its inaugural meeting on April 3, 2007. Formed through the efforts of four men: Vince Nigro of Vital Services (Moorpark), Ed Nuki of Aid Alert Security Systems (Westlake Village), Commander Tom Chronister of the Oxnard Police Department, and Senior Deputy Larry Logan of the Ventura County Sheriff's Department, the association's aim is to develop strong alliances between the municipal safety agencies and providers of security products and services to make Ventura County a safer place to live and work.

“The VCSA is very unique for two reasons. First, it is a working coalition made up of representatives from the security industry and law enforcement and fire departments within Ventura County. It creates a platform for providers of security products and services from the private sector, to meet with, and educate safety service providers from the public sector. Secondly, there are no association membership fees,” said Nigro. Nuki believes this association will pave the way to better public-private partnerships. “Public safety personnel and private security providers have the common goal of protecting lives and property, but we rarely have the opportunity to discuss shared problems or solutions. This new association will provide us this opportunity as we strive to enhance our collective effectiveness.” One focus of the Association will be to encourage and support sound legislation involving areas of safety and security, which contribute to making Ventura County a safer place to live, work and visit.

All interested representatives from law enforcement, fire, security companies, guard services companies and security equipment providers are invited to attend its meetings.
